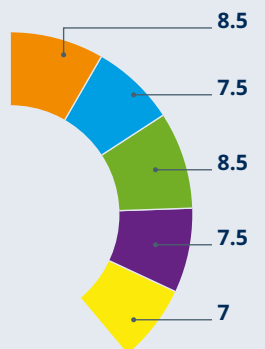

Who gets to participate in the online revolution?

To protect freedom of expression and access to information globally, it's crucial to understand the multifaceted nature of digital participation—from technical aspects to the social, economic and regulatory context. Based on our research on digital participation in eight countries with more than 100 expert and user interviews, we summarized the results visually. Categorized by country as well as by thematic cluster: Access, Rights, Media and Journalism, Innovation and Society.

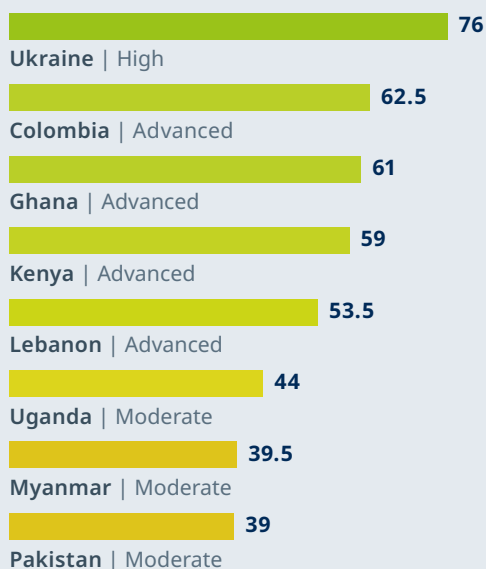

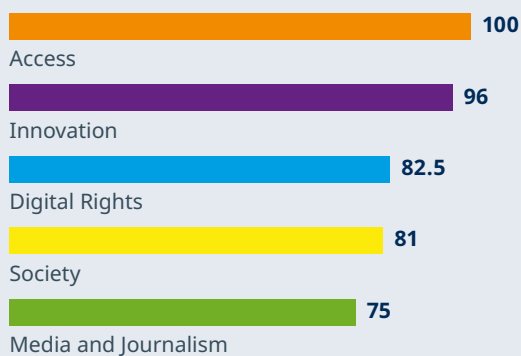
Country comparison
